CANPitch FUNDamentals	The FUNdamentals Stage is the entry level for young pitchers. At this level participants will learn the proper instruction of grip, wrist snap, arm rotation, and stride For Mite or new pitchers.	\$110	10:00 am	
CANPitch Learn2Train	The goal of this stage is to systematically build on the skills learned in the FUNdamentals Stage by increasing the speed of motion and throwing to basic targets while focusing on the coordination of the arms and legs, the power line and throwing strikes.
